• Please park buggies/push chairs in designated area

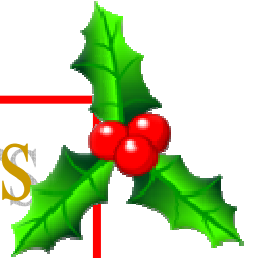
• Strictly no walkers in bumps and babies, When your child has achieved this milestone it is time to move up to toddlers
